

General Rules:

- Proper tack & show attire requested in all classes!
- ASTM/SEI approved headgear must be worn by all riders while mounted, at all times.
- Any rider/spectator/handler can be asked to leave for misconduct.
- FOUR OAKS FARM, volunteers, and property owners are not responsible for accident or injury to spectators, riders, handlers. Entry onto grounds constitutes acknowledgement of this policy.
- A signed waiver must be completed by the participant or by a parent/guardian for juniors.
- BHSA & VHSA Associate rules apply!
- This is a BHSA and VHSA Associate show, membership forms are available at the secretary's booth and must be completed and turned in by the end of the show in order for points to count. VHSA or BHSA membership is not required to compete in this show.
- Riders age as of December 1, 2011
- Judge's decision is final! Do not approach the judge except by way of the show manager.
- Show management reserves the right to combine, split, or cancel any class or division it deems necessary.
- **Year End Championships & Reserve awarded for each division at the October show.**
 - Divisions and equitation classes must be held at a minimum of half of the shows offered in order for year-end prizes to be awarded.
 - Divisions and equitation classes must be split at a minimum of half of the shows offered in order to be split for year-end awards.
- Points will accrue as follows: Champion-10, Reserve-6, 1st - 10, 2nd - 6, 3rd - 4, 4th - 2, 5th - 1, 6th - .5
- Please leave dogs at home. No dogs will be allowed on the show grounds!
- No alcoholic beverages allowed on show grounds!
- Concession stand will be available.
- There will be a \$50.00 fee for all returned checks.

Leadline: Open to riders 7 & under. To be led at the walk. No Cross Entry. Judged 50/50 rider/suitability of mount. BHSA. Saturdays Only!

Pre-Short Stirrup: Open to riders 10 & under. Riders may be asked to walk, trot & perform simple Equitation tasks. Obstacles include ground poles. No cross entry into canter or jumping classes. BHSA. Saturdays Only!

Student Equitation: Open to riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing at 2' or higher. Fences 2' Riders competing in this division are limited to 2 years only, whether they compete over fences or not. Courses may be trotted. BHSA

Directions:

From Charlottesville:

Take I-64 east to exit 136. Turn right off of the exit ramp onto 15 S, and proceed to the stoplight. Turn left at light onto 250 East. Go 1 mile and turn right onto Bybee Rd (Rt. 607) Go 1 mile and turn right onto Bybee's Church Rd (Rt. 613) Go @1.5 miles and turn left onto Dogwood (Rt. 631) Four Oaks is the First Drive on the right.

From Richmond:

Take I-64 West to exit 136. Turn left off of the exit ramp onto 15 South. Proceed to stoplight. Turn left at light onto 250 East. Follow directions from above.

From Farmville:

Take 15 North through the town of Palmyra. Pass Camp Friendship (will be on your left) and take the next road to the right, Bybee's Church Rd. (Rt. 613). Go 4 miles and turn right onto Dogwood Lane (Rt. 631) Four Oaks is the First Drive on the right.
