Class Descriptions:

1. **Leadline:** 7 yrs and under. Judged on position and appointments.
2. **Beginner Walk/Brief Trot:** 7 years and under. Judged on position and appointments. May be led.
3. **Pre-Short Stirrup:** Open to children 11 and under. May not cross enter any class where they are asked to canter or jump.
4. **Short Stirrup:** Open to riders 12 and under. May cross enter into Pleasure Divisions. *VHSA Associate Division.*
5. **Hunter Pleasure Pony:** Ponies 14.2h and under to be ridden by Jr. riders only. *VHSA Associate Division.*
6. **Pony Hunter:** Ponies 14.2h and under ridden by Jr. riders only. Sm 2', Med 2'3", Lg 2'6". *VHSA Associate Division.*
7. **VHSA Associate Pony Equitation:** Open to Jr. on ponies 14.2h and under O/F. Sm 2', Med 2'3", Lg 2'6". At least ¼ of the class will be asked to return to ride on the flat. *VHSA Associate Class.*
8. **Open 4-H Pleasure:** Open to any current 4-H member 19 yrs and under. My be in English or Western tack with an approved helmet.
9. **Hunter Pleasure Horse Jr:** Open to horses ridden by Jr. riders. *VHSA Associate Division.*
10. **Hunter Pleasure Horse Adult:** Open to horses ridden by adult riders. *VHSA Associate Division.*
11. **Low Hunter:** Open to all horses/ponies. Adults may ride ponies. Fences 2' or 2'6" rider's choice.
12. **Green Hunter:** Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences. Also open to ponies in their 1st year of showing over fences ridden by a Jr. rider only. Sm 2', Med 2'3", Lg/Horse 2'6". *VHSA Associate Division.*
13. **VHSA Associate Jr/Adult Equitation:** Open to Jr. and Adults on horses. At least ¼ of class will be asked to return to ride on the flat. *VHSA Associate Division.*
14. **Children's/Adult Hunter:** Open to Jr. and Adult Amateurs on horses only. *VHSA Associate Division.*
15. **Working Hunter:** Open to horses only. 2'9" or 3' rider's choice. *VHSA Associate Division.*
16. **California Warm Up:** An unjudged warm up class to be used one time before the division of your choice.

Pre-Entry Information: Please list horse or pony, rider (adult/jr), owner, class # and name, address, contact info or email. We will verify by phone or email that we have received your pre-entry. E-mail: Four_Oaks_Farm@yahoo.com by noon on Thursday June 11th.

Show Rules:

1. All entries must show a current negative Coggins test (taken within 12 months) before number can be issued.
2. Proper tack and show attire required in all classes. ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.
3. Four Oaks Farm, volunteers, property owners are not responsible for accident or injury to spectators, riders, handlers. Entry onto grounds constitutes acknowledgement of this policy.
4. VHSA Associate rules apply.
5. Rider's age as of December 1, 2008, except for 4-H classes.
6. Judge's decision is final. Please do not approach the judge except by way of the show manager.
7. Show management reserves the right to combine, split, or cancel any class or division it deems necessary.
8. High Point Horse, Pony, Trainer awarded at the end of the show.
9. Points will accrue as follows: Champion-10, Reserve-6, 1st-5, 2nd-3, 3rd-2, 4th-1, 5th-0.
10. No dogs or alcoholic beverages allowed on show grounds.
11. Concession stand will be available on the grounds.
12. There will be a "For Sale" board beside the secretary stand. Please post your ads there.
13. There will be a \$25.00 fee for all returned checks.

Directions From Charlottesville:

Take I-64 East to exit 136. Turn right off of the exit ramp onto 15 South, and proceed to the stoplight.

Turn left at light onto 250 East.

Go 1 mile and turn right onto Bybee Rd (Rt. 607)

Go 1 mile and turn right onto Bybee's Church Rd (Rt. 613)

Go @1.5 miles and turn left onto Dogwood (Rt. 631)

Four Oaks is the First Drive on the right.

Directions From Richmond:

Take I-64 West to exit 136. Turn left off of the exit ramp onto 15 South and proceed to stoplight.

Turn left at light onto 250 East.

Follow directions from above.

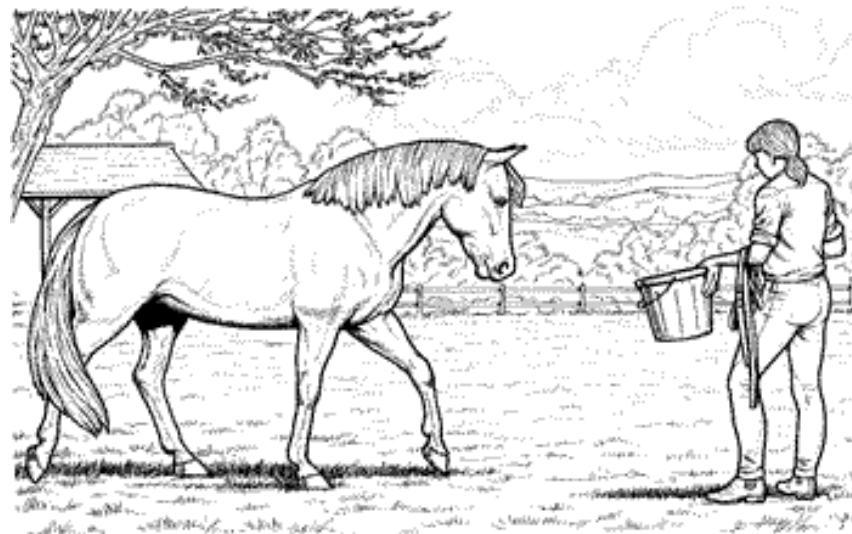
Directions From Farmville:
