### **General Rules:**

- Current negative Coggins required for each horse & pony entering the show grounds.
- o A waiver must be signed by the participant or parent/guardian for juniors.
- o Proper tack & show attire required in all classes.
- o ASTM/SEI approved headgear is required at all times while mounted.
- o Any rider/spectator/handler may be asked to leave for misconduct.
- Four Oaks Farm, volunteers, and property owners are not responsible for accident or injury to spectators, riders, handlers. Entry onto grounds constitutes acknowledgement of this policy.
- BHSA, TIP & VHSA Associate rules apply. VHSA Associate rules take precedence.
  - When competing in VHSA recognized divisions, the entry must have completed at least one over fences course in order to compete in the under saddle class.
- BHSA, TIP & VHSA Associate show membership forms are available at the secretary's booth. These completed forms must be turned in to show staff by the end of the show for same day points to count.
- O VHSA, BHSA or TIP membership is not required to compete in this show.
- o Rider's age as of December 1, 2018.
- Judge's decision is final. Do not approach the judge, except by way of the show manager.
- Show management reserves the right to combine, split, or cancel any class or division it deems necessary.
- Champion & Reserve Champion awarded for year-end in each division at the October show. High Point Horse & High Point Pony are also awarded.
  - All classes must be held at half of the shows offered in order to be eligible for year-end awards.
  - All classes must be split at half of the shows offered in order to be split for yearend awards.
  - o Ties for year-end awards will be broken as follows:
    - 1. Number of Champions received
    - 2. Number of Reserve Champions received
    - 3. Number of first place ribbons received
    - 4. Number of shows attended
  - Year-end award qualifiers, or a representative, must be present at the year-end show in order to receive awards.
- Points will accrue as follows: Champion 10, Reserve 6
  - $\circ$  1 5 entries: 1<sup>st</sup> 10, 2<sup>nd</sup> 6, 3<sup>rd</sup> 4, 4<sup>th</sup> 2, 5<sup>th</sup> 1, 6<sup>th</sup> 0.5
  - $\circ$  6 9 entries: 1st 11, 2nd 7, 3rd 5, 4th 3, 5th 2, 6th 1.5
  - $\circ \geq 10 \text{ entries: } 1^{\text{st}} 12, 2^{\text{nd}} 8, 3^{\text{rd}} 6, 4^{\text{th}} 4, 5^{\text{th}} 3, 6^{\text{th}} 2.5$
- High Point Horse & High Point Pony points accrue from Champion & Reserve Champion points.
- o High Point TIP Thoroughbred points accrue from all hunter points received.
- o Please leave dogs at home.
- o No alcoholic beverages allowed on show grounds.
- Concession stand will be available.
- We accept cash, check (\$50 fee for returned checks) & all major credit cards as payment. There is a \$5 processing fee for credit cards.
- Any unresolved fees will result in a forfeiture of series points until payment & all bank fees are received.
